The Court:- The instant application has been filed under Clause 13 of the Letters Patent, inter alia, praying for transfer of the Title Suit No.775/2017 (Vijay Agarwal vs. LICI) pending before the 11<sup>th</sup> Bench, Learned City Civil Court, Calcutta to this Hon'ble Court as an extra ordinary suit.

Ms. Sayani Gupta, learned advocate appearing for the respondents would submit that, a Rule in connection with the aforesaid application has been served on the respondents.
